Membership Criteria / Commitment:

Membership at Beth El is a relationship and true partnership, where members are aligned with a desire to be part of a synagogue community dedicated to Jewish learning, spirituality, and tikkun olam. In turn, Beth El establishes a warm and welcoming learning environment, provides spiritual guidance, inspires activities to repair the world, and facilitates meaningful opportunities for community involvement and congregational leadership.

The relationship is mutually beneficial and the investment is shared, as members provide participation, volunteer support, and financial contributions which support this home.

Membership at Beth El is not viewed through a financial lens and members are not required to pay dues. Anyone who wants to be a member, may consent to be a member and is welcome to participate and engage in our many programs and events, including Shabbat morning services and holiday celebrations.

Membership Consent:

You are eligible to be a member of Beth El Synagogue if you provide written or verbal communication to Beth El clergy or staff leadership, indicating that you would like to be a member.

Examples of ways to consent include, but are not limited to;

- ✓ You were considered a member during the previous year, and did not request to discontinue your membership; or
- ✓ You make a one-time or ongoing financial contribution to Beth El, and indicate that you would like to be considered a member; or
- ✓ You participate in a Beth El Synagogue event, and indicate through registration that you would like to be a member; or
- ✓ You volunteer your time and energy to Beth El, and through that process indicate that you would like to be a member of Beth El; or
- ✓ You call, email, or send a letter to the Beth El Synagogue office indicating that you would like to be a member.
