

In order to provide our community with opportunities to stay busy and keep up with schoolwork and activities throughout hybrid and distance learning, Beth El is offering exciting programming for families. Virtual options are available based on the age of the children. Trimesters will be September-December, January-March, April-June.

All the options are completely virtual. The next trimester of classes begin January 4.

For Toddlers:

This is a chance for toddlers to learn from home while still receiving the valuable preschool and Jewish education that Aleph Preschool is known for. We are offering three Virtual Zoom classes weekly (30 minutes a session): Mondays will be Havdalah, Wednesdays will be Fitness Movement to Music with Stretch and Grow, and Fridays will be Shabbat. Children will participate in morning tefilot (prayers), brachot (blessings), and learn fun facts related to these rituals. Additionally, children will learn about the holidays and Torah portions through stories and songs.

- 3 virtual classes (30 Minutes) Monday, Wednesday, Friday 9:30-10, one device per sign up
- Trimester cost: \$270.00

For Preschool and Pre-K:

Math/Science, Language/Literature, Hebrew This option provides children an opportunity for virtual interaction without the full day commitment of in-class instruction. There will be two full-group virtual Judaic experiences a week: Havdalah and Shabbat where children will participate in morning tefilot (prayers), brachot (blessings), and learn fun facts related to these rituals. Additionally, children will learn about the holidays and Torah portions through stories and songs. In addition to the virtual experiences, we will provide three virtual 30-minute enrichment classes every week plus 10 minutes of check in and looking ahead. These classes will be focused on Math/Science, Language/Literature, and Hebrew language.

- 2 virtual (30 Minutes) Mondays at 10:00 AM, Fridays at 9:30 AM 1st and 3rd Fridays of the month and 10:00 AM 2nd and 4th Fridays of the month
- 3 virtual (30 Minutes + 10 min check in) Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday 10:00 AM
- Trimester cost: \$540.00

For Kindergarten-6th Grade:

Distance Learning Support This option will provide families access to an experienced teacher with the goal of supporting distance learning provided through the public or private schools. For an hour a session, support could include, but is not limited to, organization of tasks, help finishing assignments, keeping students on track, explaining difficult topics, and providing enrichment opportunities to learn more. Families can schedule 1 hour a week or 3 hours a week.

FAQs

When is trimester? Are there any days with no class?

The trimester lasts 12 weeks. It will start the week of January 4th with the last week starting March 22nd. There will be no lessons on President's Day, February 15th.

How are teachers chosen/qualified?

All our teachers are either currently or previously licensed or have many years of experience. They have all been vetted and background checked.

Do I need to be present for my child's lesson?

We ask that you do not leave your child completely alone for a lesson. If you are virtual, please stay in the house and remain within earshot.
